Ensure that all personnel involved in the company's operations have the skills, understanding and appropriate training to properly carry out their duties and responsibilities.

Develop best environmental practice with our suppliers, and monitor this in conjunction with supplier evaluation procedures.

Continually strive to improve environmental performance and to achieve these goals using those methods and operations which manage all health and safety, public, process and product safety issues. Where pertinent, our results will be made available for public review except where an unfair advantage could be gained by our competitors.

Provide effective control to afford time and resources for the implementation of the policy and to review it annually.
